	<p>Strong & Supportive: Young Men as Allies, Rethinking Masculinity (Formation Module for Male Students)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● This session is designed as a guided learning and reflection space for male students that complements the Conversations with female students in the Gender Hub program. It provides young men with the opportunity to critically explore how gender norms and expectations shape their identities, relationships, and behaviors — particularly in how they relate with others in their community.
